

Liberals, NDP block investigation into partisan vetting of judges

Ottawa, ON – Michael Cooper, Conservative Member of the Justice Committee, and Jacques Gourde, MP for Lévis—Lotbinière, issued the following statement on the Liberals and NDP teaming up to block an immediate investigation into the Liberals’ partisan vetting of judges:

“Today, the Liberals and NDP made a deal to block an immediate investigation into the partisan vetting of judges by the Trudeau government.

“It’s clear that Justin Trudeau, with his allies in the NDP, want to cover up the unethical and corrupt Liberal practice of using a partisan database to vet and select judges.

“This is what Canadians have come to expect from Justin Trudeau and the Liberals. When they are caught doing the wrong thing, they do whatever they can to cover up the truth from Canadians.

“If you’re not worried about the unethical and corrupt behaviour from the Trudeau Liberals, you have three parties to choose from. If you are, you only have one – Canada’s Conservatives.”
